My only criticism would be that the guitars and bass could have been louder, though I think this was mainly due to technical issues with the PA and mics, and the fact that this was a bar gig, with the volumes limits that apply. However I'm sure I'll get the chance to see them in a proper Rock Venue with amps and PA turned up to 11 – the sooner the better! Overall, a fun night of cool rock acts – again a big thanks to Gary and Gordon for making it all possible! :)
